AKP/KWF may authorize other types of protective equipment, provided that they offer the same level of safety and have characteristics similar to the approved equipment. Their use will always be subject to the approval of the Championship Chief Judge.

6.1 KATA

The Kata competition will be held in two rounds when there are more than four competitors in the category. The four competitors with the highest scores will advance to the final.

Participants must carefully select the correct weight category. If the verified weight does not correspond to that indicated on the registration form, the refereeing team may determine a change of category or prevent participation in that category.

The organization and refereeing team may adjust or combine categories when there are not enough participants. Each participant must identify themselves with their AKP Membership Card and KWF Passport or an official identification document.

The final registration deadline will be announced/confirmed by the organization before the definitive publication of this bulletin.

Weigh-in and verification will take place on Friday, 16 October, until 10:00 p.m. at the official hotel, and on Saturday, 17 October, at 9:00 a.m. at the sports hall.

8. VERIFICATION, CHECK-IN AND WEIGH-IN

Verification will be supervised by AKP members.

The participation fee is €30 per athlete, per discipline. Payment must be made online at the time of registration. If it has not been paid online, it must be settled with the AKP Treasurer.

An athlete participating in both Kumite and Kata will pay a total fee of €50.

At check-in and weigh-in, the participant must present the following documents:

- Parental authorization, for participants under 18 years of age, and the athlete liability waiver form.
- Identification document or passport, to verify nationality and age.
- Medical certificate, for Kumite competitors only.
- Proof of payment of the participation fee, when applicable.
- AKP/KWF members must present their respective KWF Passport.

9. REFEREEING COURSE

The Refereeing Course and coaches' meeting will take place at a time and location to be announced in Bulletin No. 2.

Participation in the refereeing course is free of charge, except for participants wishing to obtain the title of Judge or Referee awarded by the Portuguese Kyokushin Federation.

Fees: National Judge — €30; National Referee — €50.

10. SAYONARA

On Saturday evening, the Sayonara Party will be held and will be open to all participants and accompanying persons. We hope to have the pleasure of your presence.

The cost is €35 per person. Tickets may be purchased on Friday during registration.
